PARTIAL LIST OF BENEVOLENCES IN 2014 COORDINATED WITH THE OFFICE OF THE CHAPLAIN AT PHILADELPHIA PARK:

- 31 full beds (mattress, frame, and box spring),
 16 high quality air mattresses, and over 300 blankets, sheets and pillows
- 689 boxes of food, and 84 turkeys with all the 'fixins'

- 61 gift certificates for groceries at local markets for over \$3,700.00
- 233 good or new jackets (a large percentage of these were new winter coats for children), and countless other items of clothing
- 28 microwaves, 11 refrigerators, and a few other appliances (most were new)
- 48 bicycles (20 were new and all were in good condition)
- 217 book bags filled with school supplies
- 250 Easter Baskets with candy, toys, and gospel messages
- 89 Bibles
- Over 800 pairs of socks, countless hats, scarves, gloves, towels, wash cloths, toiletries, loaves of bread, and more
- There were 69 Chapel n' Chows in 2014 as well, and most of these provided many meals of leftovers
- In coordination with the PTHA and the Racing Office over 5,200 meals were provided through the meal ticket and meal card program at the Race Track Café
- Over 1,000 gifts were collected throughout the year for Christmas (and birthdays) for over 300 children
- Several holiday/seasonal parties throughout the year for children and families
- Transportation to doctor visits, pharmacies, and many other transportation needs
- \$7,000.00 Dollars in Scholarships for Colleges and Technical Schools AND MUCH MORE

I look forward to 2015 with optimism knowing that I am supported by such a good community of saints. It is a privilege to serve the Lord here. Together, with God, we will make 2015 even better than 2014! In the spirit of St. Valentine's Day I share with you and close with this Scripture passage:
